

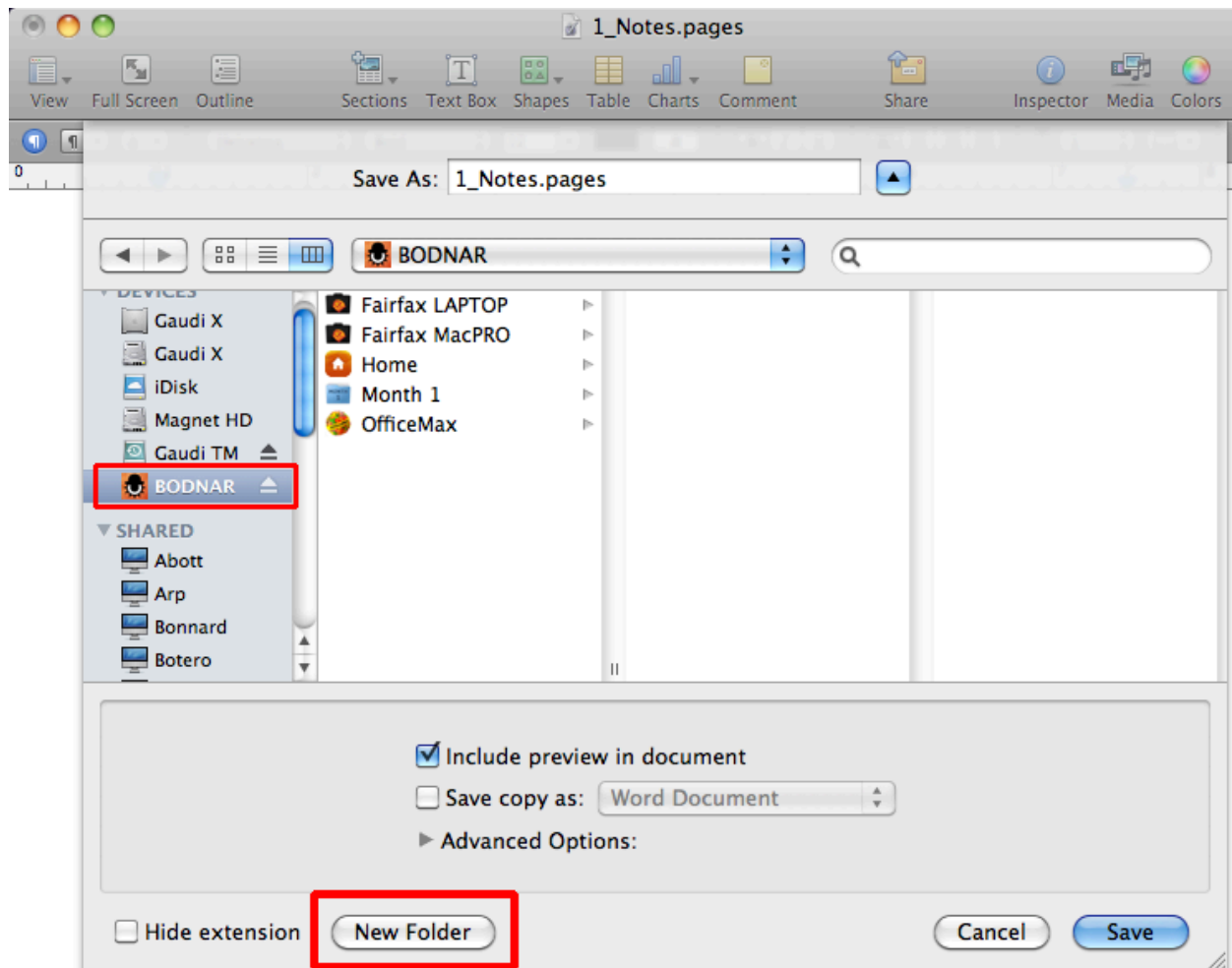

CREATE A NEW FOLDER

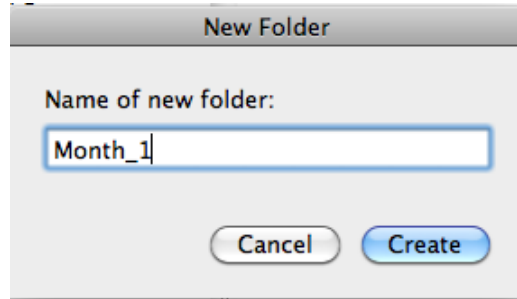
STEP 1: While in Pages, navigate to **File > Save as...**

STEP 2: Look for YOUR FLASH DRIVE on the left side under the heading "DEVICES". Note how my Flash drive is called "BODNAR".

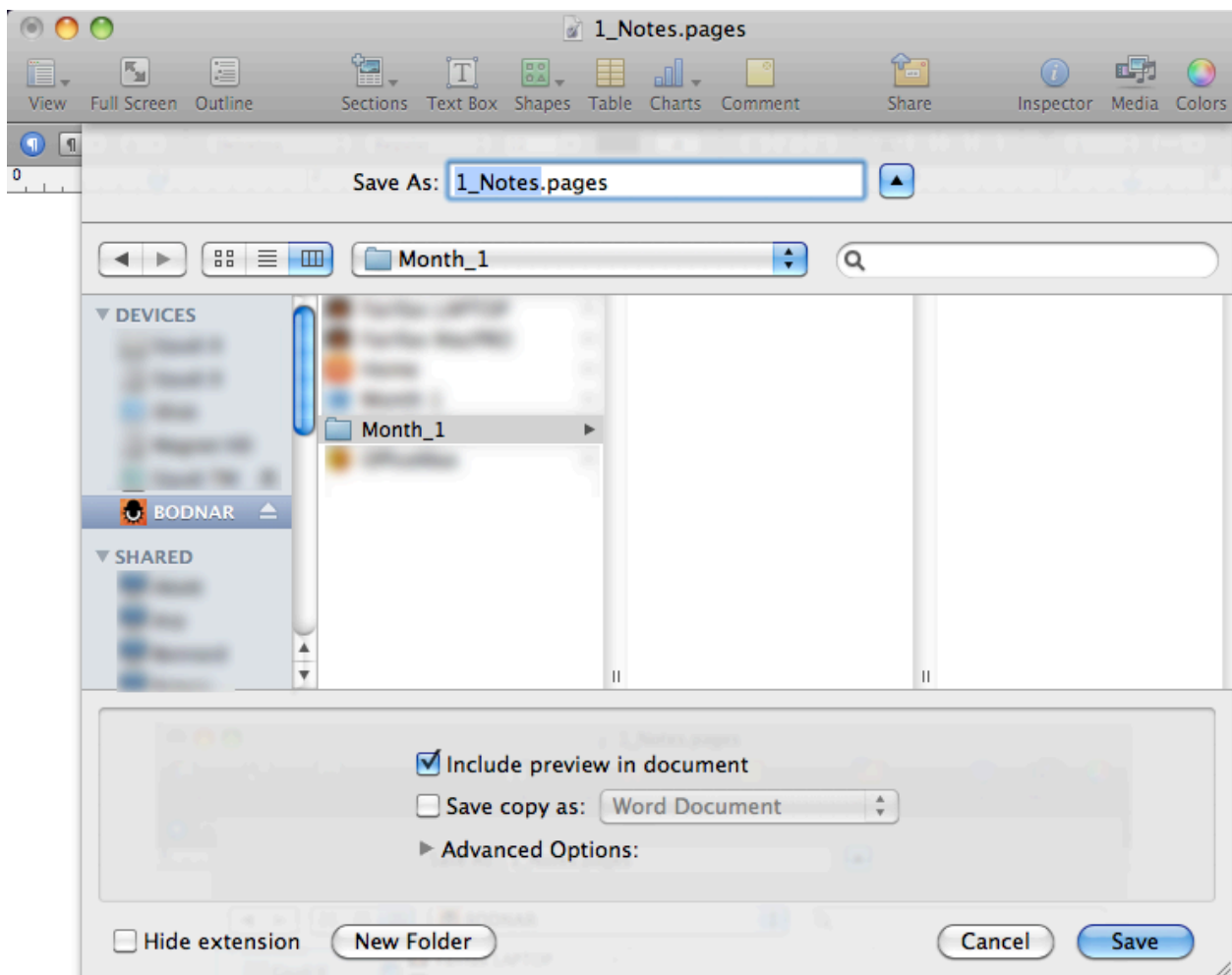


STEP 3: Press the button called **New Folder** (seen above)

STEP 4: Rename this folder **Month_1**



Note how you have now created a New Folder in your flash drive! (See image below)

COMPARE AND CONTRAST PHOTOSHOP TO ILLUSTRATOR

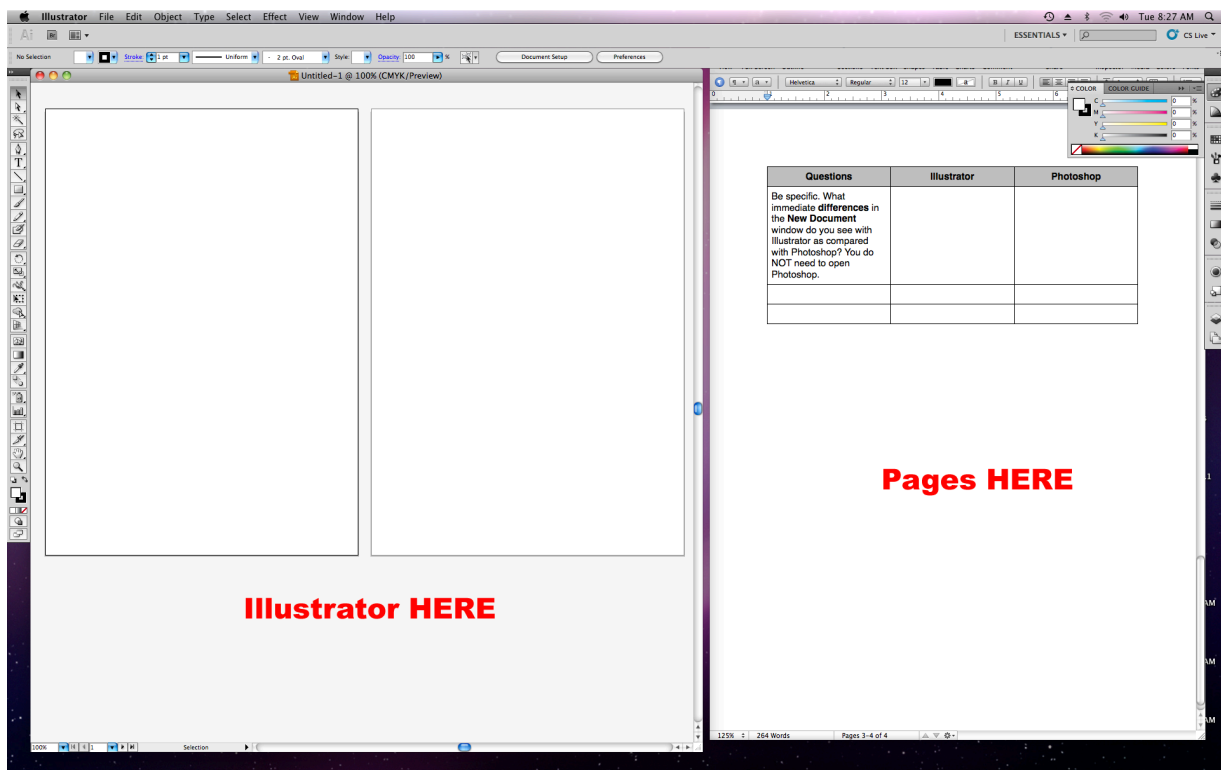
Part 1

STEP 2: If you haven't already done so, open your Illustrator **book** to page 13. When this assignment is completed, the image on this page should be the result of your efforts!





<p>Page 15: How is the Rectangle tool different from Photoshop's Rectangular Marquee tool?</p>		
<p>Page 15: How are these buttons/options different to Photoshop's Foreground and Background Colors buttons?</p> 		
<p>Page 16: What Photoshop tool is similar to Illustrator's Shape Builder tool? <i>Hint: It makes this kind of layer:</i></p> 		
<p>Page 17: Look at Step 6 in your book. What is this tool in Illustrator? <i>How</i> would you perform this similar action in Photoshop?</p>
